



## Valentine Candy Boxes

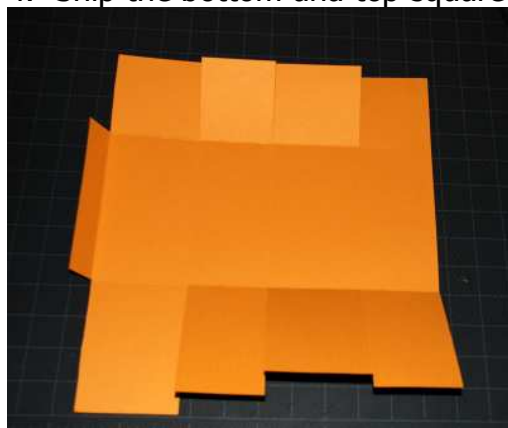
(made with the Jan 2010 Solo Kit)

**Supplies:** 1 sheet 12x12 cardstock  
Scraps of PP and embellishments  
Oval cutter, scoring tool, and decorative scissors

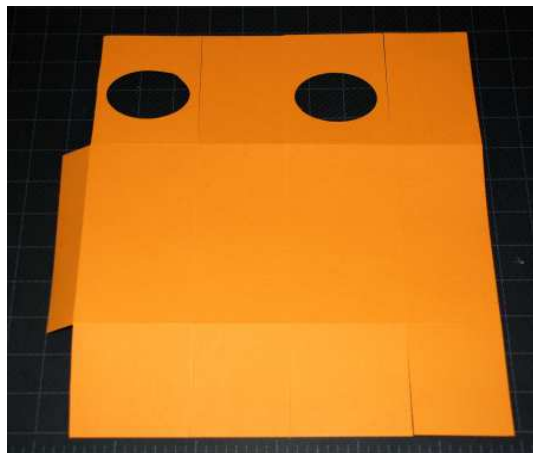
### Directions:

Make the box

1. On one side of your 12x12 piece of cardstock score at 2.5 inches and 8 inches.
2. Rotate your paper 90 degrees and score at 1, 4, 6.5 and 9.5 inches. These scores should be perpendicular to the other scores.
3. On one side you will have a 1 inch 'lip', cut the lip off except for the middle section.
4. Snip the bottom and top square apart, leaving the middle piece intact (see picture below)



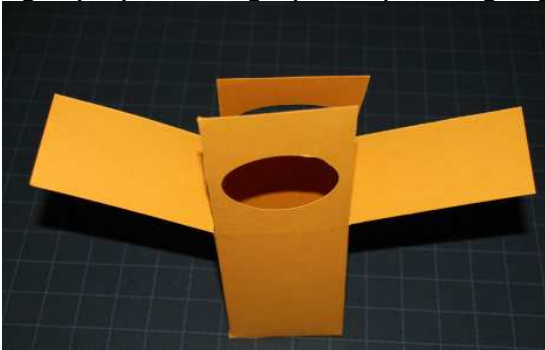
5. In the longer sections on the scored sheet, cut ovals in the second and fourth section to make the handles. Your sheet should look like the picture below. Trim handles with decorative scissors if desired.



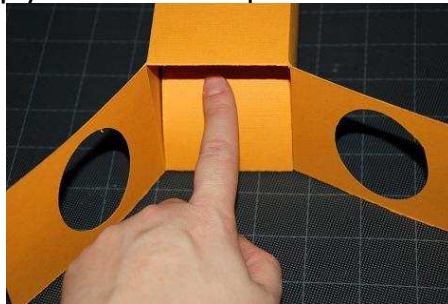
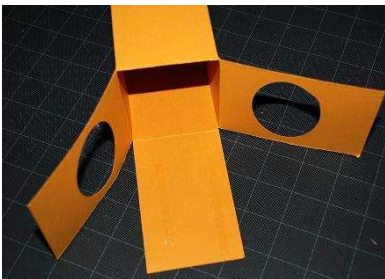
6. Apply adhesive onto the 1 inch lip and fold sides to make the body of the box



7. Apply adhesive to three of the bottom pieces and fold in to make bottom. Be sure they are secured tightly by standing up and pressing a glue bottle into the bottom.



8. On the two extra top flaps, apply adhesive and push inside box to give more strength.



9. Decorate the front as desired. Use a brad to secure the top, or punch 2 holes off center and tie a piece of ribbon through. Fill with candy and give as a yummy Valentine treat!
